Read John 2:1-11

- 1. If some believe in a god at all, it is a god that they have created. Someone said, "God created humanity in His image and then humanity returned the favor." What are some ways people do that?
- 2. One of the ways we try to make God like us is to explain away the supernatural. Those who reject the supernatural would say, "If something cannot be logically and scientifically explained, then it did not happen." What are your thoughts on the supernatural?
- 3. "Those who deny the supernatural also deny their own salvation." The greatest miracle ever performed is the miracle of our salvation. Do you agree? Why or why not?
- 4. There is a distinct difference between Jesus and the one who prepared the way for Him, John the Baptist.
 Instead of being a voice in the wilderness,
 Jesus' ministry included the difficult challenge of doing life with people.
 Why can working with people be so difficult?
- 5. Read verse 3. The scriptures do not say it's wrong to drink. But the scriptures DO condemn getting drunk. Proverbs 20:1, Romans 13:13, Galatians 5:21, Ephesians 5:18
- 6. Is it wrong to drink? It could be wrong for you. Read Proverbs 27:12 in several translations.
- 7. Read verse 4. In that culture, and in that language, the word "woman" was used like we would use the word "ma'am". It is a term of respect.
