Read John 9:1-12

1. Try to imagine what it would be like to be blind.

2. Read verse 2

This question tells us a lot about the hearts of the disciples at this time. Instead of seeing the blind man as someone who needed mercy or someone who desperately needed help, they could only see the blind man as the subject for a good theological argument.

3. Describe legalism

4. Do not let your Bible study become the means to the end. The goal for Bible reading and Bible study is not to grow your head but to grow your heart. What are some practical ways to do that?

5. How can you be on guard against legalism?

6. Do not allow your focus to be on "how" things happen, instead focus on "who" makes it happen.

7. Do not allow your knowledge to puff you up. As you grow in the Word, ask God to help you grow in humility.

8. Do not be like the disciples who wanted to debate the cause of the man's blindness. Instead, be more like Jesus who wanted to take care of his problem.
